Strength, Passion and Focus -- three words we have chosen to represent Jack's Fund this year.

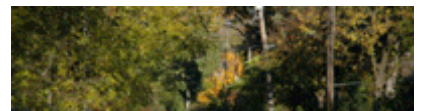
- **Strength:** To run the hills with courage and hope.

ENTRY FEES: Race entry fees are determined by freewill individual or family donations, with the first 1,000 registered participants guaranteed an event t-shirt.

PRE-REGISTRATION PACKET PICKUP: All those who pre-register by Thursday, October 19, may pick up their race packets at the Glen Ellyn Running Company at the following times:

- Thursday, October 19, 3-6 p.m.
- Friday, October 20, 3-6 p.m.
- Saturday, October 21, 9-1 p.m.

Day of event registration is also accepted just prior to the race, from 6:45-7:40 a.m. on Sunday, October 22 at Ackerman Park.

NEW * RUNNERS RESULTS AND AWARDS: The event course is sanctioned and certified by USATF and awards will be presented to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place overall male and female finishers. All runners will receive an instant results card from DRKcomputing.

GEAR CHECK AND PUMPKINS FOR SALE: Runners gear check will be available and Glenbard West students will again be selling pumpkins.

DIRECTIONS: Ackerman Park, site of the race, is at the intersection of St. Charles and Riford Roads in Glen Ellyn, west of IL Rte. 53 and I-355, south of North Avenue and East of Main Street/Glen Ellyn Road.
