

In 2005 Jack's Fund was chosen as an Associated Charity of The LaSalle Bank Chicago Marathon. A team of 10 athletes ran the 26.2 LaSalle Bank Chicago Marathon in Jack's honor and raised over \$10,000 for melanoma research. This new marathon connection also led to our partnership with 2005 female winner, Deena Kastor, a melanoma survivor, and supporter of the Fund's efforts to battle the disease.

The 2006 Jack's Marathon Team has almost tripled in size and has attracted runners from all over the country. The Team's fundraising efforts are projected to top \$20,000. We are proud of our official affiliation with The LaSalle Bank Chicago Marathon and look forward to using this charity effort as a force to battle this disease for many years to come.
